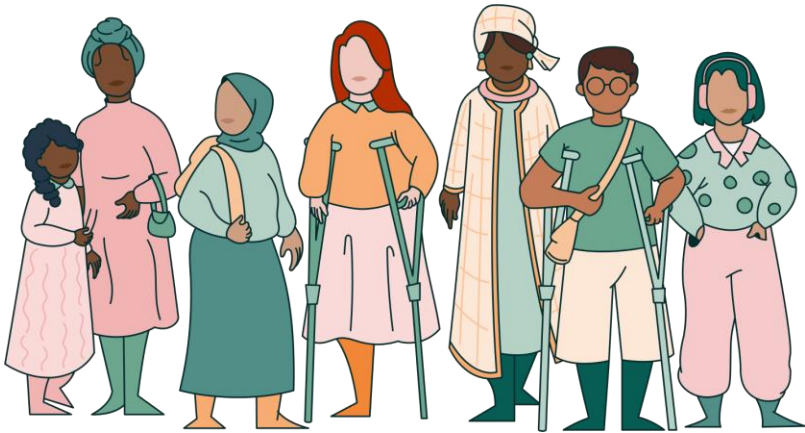

- The Hub aims to make these resources **more accessible to a wide range of stakeholders.**

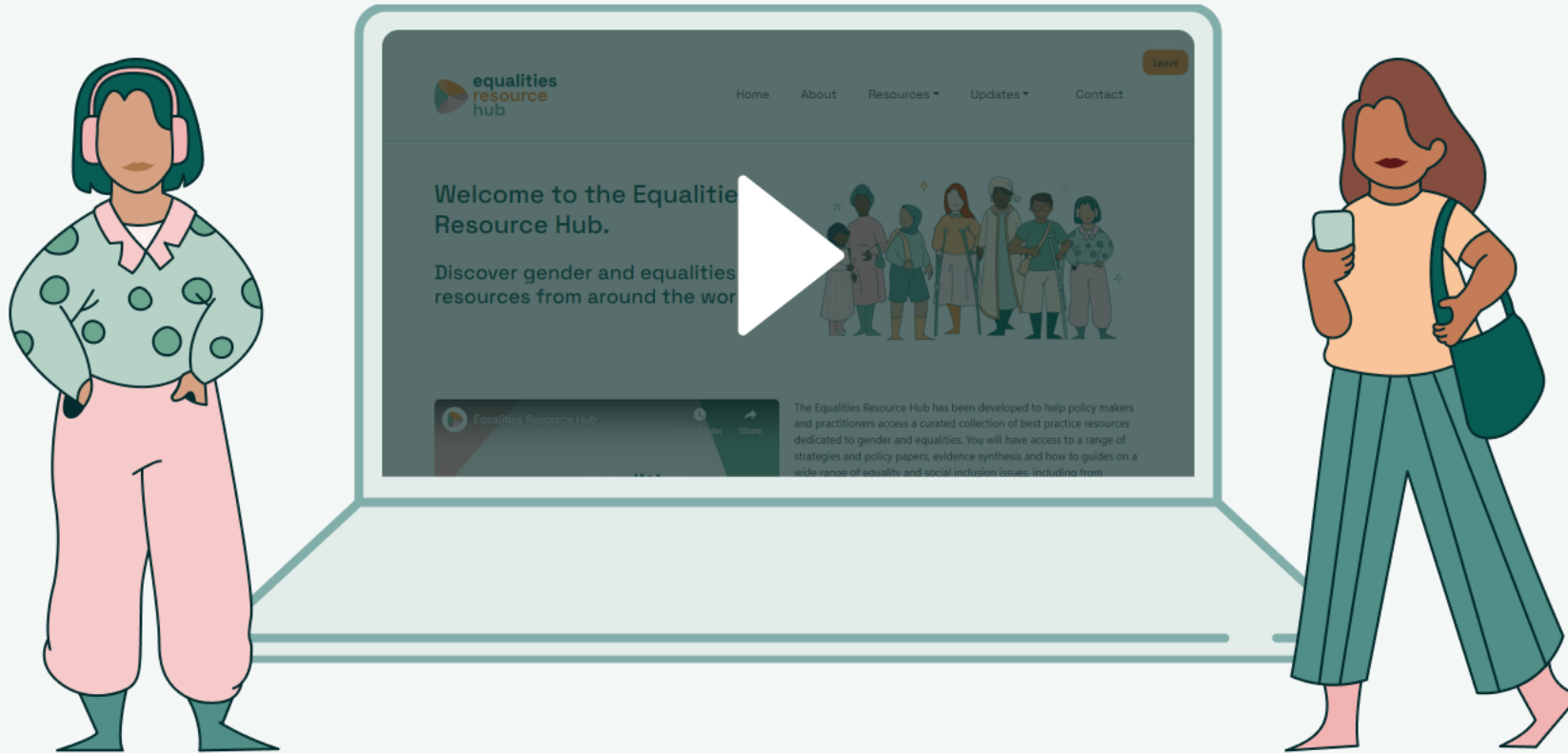
What is the Equalities Resource Hub?
